One division of the company, The Fabric Peddler, was spun off in 1995 and continues to operate today as a separate company. In 2005 he sold Bentley Sales to a division of Leggett and Platt, Inc.

David was responsible for all aspects of the day-to-day operations of Bentley Sales, including manufacturing, purchasing, importing, converting, and selling of fabric for the decorative fabric industry. He has knowledge of fabric construction, finishing and printing. Since selling his company in 2005, he was involved with The Fabric Peddler until 2007, when he decided to retire. Fortunately, for O Ecotextiles, he didn’t like retirement.
